
Bruised rib removing guard

While removing a guard on a mobile crusher to inspect where smoke was coming from, a worker underestimated the weight of the guard and struggled to hold it.

As he removed the guard he slipped and took a backwards step from the mobile crusher onto a stockpile.

In the process the guard struck him, bruising his ribs. There were no other injuries.

MinEx data on incidents with the potential to cause harm over the 5 years to Mar 2022, shows 16% (771) of all incidents result from falls, with 321 incidents resulting from fall of a person.



You need to ensure that:

- Appropriate mechanical aids and equipment are available to avoid injuries to workers from lifting, carrying, pushing or pulling heavy loads.
- Equipment used for lifting is used properly and maintained in accordance with Original Manufacturers Specifications.
- Workers are trained and competent in safe handling methods and how to safely use any mechanical aids and equipment.
