Another breach of procedure

An articulated dump truck passed through a loader exclusion zone while a loader was loading a truck.

The exclusion zone was not well defined, and the ADT operator failed to communicate with the loader operator per documented procedures.

Though no one was injured, the potential for a serious incident was high.



MinEx data on incidents with the potential to cause harm over the 5 years to September 2022 show 15% (759) of all incidents involve breach of a procedure. Between July and September 2022, 31% of incidents reported to MinEx were a result of breach of a procedure.

You need to ensure to:

- 1. That safe work procedures (SWPs) are based on risk assessment and developed by the workers who use them, reflecting how work is done.
- 2. All workers are trained and assessed as competent in SWPs that they are expected to follow.
- 3. SWPs are kept up-to-date and are always readily available to workers.
- 4. SWPs are written in such a way that they are easily understood by all workers.
