Potential fall from height incident

A mechanic was working on the bonnet of a Komatsu 275 bulldozer without wearing any fall protection equipment (harness) or without any edge protection to protect him from a potential fall of 2.8 metres.

Serious injuries have occurred in the extractives sector as a result of falls from plant and equipment during maintenance.



MinEx statistics on incidents with the potential to cause harm over the past 5 years show 16% of incidents (963 incidents) result from falls of which 368 incidents resulted from fall of a person.

You need to ensure that:

- Appropriate controls are in place to protect workers from falls when working at height such as fall barriers, working platforms, harnesses etc.
- 2. Risk assessments and safe operating procedures identify what controls are to be in place before commencing work at height.
- 3. Regular workplace inspections are conducted to identify fall hazards including during maintenance.
