Raised loader bucket incidents

A loader was travelling toward the crushing plant with the bucket lifted. It was turning to head into a bin when it hit a concrete block, breaking a grease line on the boom.

No injuries were sustained during this incident.

There have been a number of recent incidents where a lifted loader bucket has affected operator visibility.



MinEx data on incidents with the potential to cause harm over the past 5 years show 30% (1,649) of all incidents involve vehicles, of which 821 resulted from collision of vehicles.

You need to ensure:

- 1. Loader buckets are not lifted when the loader is travelling or prior to trucks entering the loading zone, to ensure clear visibility is maintained.
- 2. All mobile plant operators are trained and assessed as competent to operate individual pieces of mobile equipment.
- 3. Suitable clear access is available for mobile plant around fixed plant, including bins.
