While January 1 is the key date by which to have your CoC in place, WorkSafe is advising you need to get your applications for renewals in by mid November to ensure it is processed in time. If not processed you will have to apply for a new CoC and not be able to operate according to the regs. This is made clear in this WorkSafe newsletter.

As you will see, a worrying number aren't yet through their CoCs, particularly quarry managers' B-grade, where nearly two-thirds have not yet completed their competencies.

WorkSafe says come next January those without the necessary CoC to undertake their required management role will at best be given an improvement notice, or potentially be banned from working.

Oral exams are providing particularly difficult for some people. <u>Look here</u> if you are doing oral exams for some advice from WorkSafe.

The oral exam is about how well you can apply what you know in an operation - it's about what you would do or how you would handle a situation.
