

All incidents: All Operations – by category (including potentials/near hits)


All Operations

All Incidents July 2020 to September 2022






All Operations - All Incidents July 2017 to September 2022

Trends across 2022

- Significant increase in number of incidents reported (particularly breaches of procedure)
- Repeat incidents continued
- Staffing issues, high demand
- Health and wellbeing receiving more attention
- Regulation changes at last





Harassment Enquiry West Australia

FIFO mines in WA including Rio Tinto, BHP and Fortesque

 100 submissions including over 20 women giving evidence of sexual harassment

- Male dominated culture
- Companies knew but did very little
- Victims lost their jobs for raising issue



Insights from Jodie Goodall

- Leaders need to recognise that systems don't always perform as expected and instead should become preoccupied with the risk of failure – something she calls 'chronic unease.'
- Still too much belief that human error caused fatalities and serious injuries and there was nothing you can do
- You manage what you measure so measure the right things
- Need to concentrate on fatal hazards and critical controls
- Be in touch with workers your frontline experts





Great leaders ask great questions

Dumb – What doesn't make sense to you about the work we are doing or how we are doing it?

Difficult – What tasks do you find difficult or hard to do well?

Different – What has changed or is changing relative to how things are usually done or should be done?

Dangerous – What feels risky to you about the work you do?
